Federal law requires all businesses to have at least one handicapped parking space. More than 26 spaces require additional handicapped spots. To assist businesses in fulfilling their responsibilities under the law, and as a special project, the Williston Police Explorers will be offering to spray paint appropriate blue lane and handicapped symbols on the pavement for any business requesting the service.

Business owners should schedule an appointment by calling the Police Department at 528-4991 and asking to speak with Officer Deonarine, the Post advisor. A small donation would be appreciated to cover the cost of supplies and to support the Post.
